Dear Friends

Last Wednesday, completely by chance I bumped into Cardinal Nichols in the departure lounge at Heathrow where I work. We spoke for perhaps ten minutes or so during which time the Cardinal informed me that Pope Francis has gifted some relics of The True Cross to The King for his forthcoming coronation. They have been incorporated into a newly made Cross of Wales which will be used at the head of the coronation procession in Westminster Abbey.

The Cardinal's journey was planned, I guess to an extent you could argue that the King's Journey has been planned, although it would be fair to state that his almost 70 years as first in line to the throne it has been a long plan. His coronation has certainly been planned and in all probability much of it while the late Oueen was still alive.

Today's gospel informs us of many things, and one of these things is that an encounter with Our Lord Jesus Christ can lead us on an unexpected journey.

It must be about ten or twelve years ago when I was first talking to Fr Chris Vipers about the possibility of exploring the permanent diaconate. To be honest I was 'umming' and 'arring' a bit.

Anyway Fr Chris told me to allow myself to be guided by the Holy Spirit. Wise words that have stayed with me throughout my ministry.

Now this Holy Spirit was the same Holy Spirit that the disciples encountered on the Road to Emmaus all those years ago. It is the same Holy Spirit that guides the Cardinal as leader of the Catholic Church in England and Wales and it is the same Holy Spirit that guides The King "At the breaking of the Bread their eyes were opened and they recognised him". This is one of the most profound pieces of scripture, the breaking of the bread reminds us of the Last Supper and the Last Supper reminds us of a shared experience of worship and communion.

Just like the disciples at the time of the resurrection, we are a community of Catholic Christians encountering Our Lord Jesus Christ, and I know this is often challenging, but just like Luke suggests, our encounter will sometimes take us to places where we wouldn't have chosen to go, or indeed force us to stay where we would rather not be.

But whatever the Holy Spirit is guiding us to do then it is for our own good, because The Holy Spirit will always be with us, during the week when most of us can't get to Mass, and on Sundays at the shared "last supper" experience of worship and communion.
