Dear Friends,

One of my favourite spiritual writers is Carlo Carretto. His books on prayer and contemplation have helped so many people, perhaps his most famous being “*Letters From The Desert*”, continue to be published and read today. In 1984 he wrote his *Spiritual Testament*, which ends with an extraordinary “*love letter*” addressed to the Church.

In this letter he says:

*“How much I criticize you, my Church, but yet how much I love you!
You have made me suffer more than anyone. And yet I owe you more than I owe any other person.*

I should like to see you destroyed. But I need your presence.

You have caused me so much scandal. And yet you alone have taught me to understand the true meaning of holiness. Countless times I have wanted to slam the door of my soul in your face; yet every night I pray to die in your arms.

No! I cannot be free of you; I cannot leave you, for I am one with you - even though not completely one. But if I leave, where should I go? What would I do? Build another Church? But I cannot build another Church without the same defects. Why? Because they are MY defects too.

And again, if I were to build another Church, it would be MY Church and not Christ's Church...”

Carlo Carretto experienced the Church as he experienced himself: flawed, yet divine, able to reveal the amazing love and mercy of God, and able to obscure it and destroy it too. And the same reality he discovered in his own life too. Perhaps this is your experience also? Perhaps you could write a similar “*love letter*” too? I am always encouraged when I read these words, because it is my experience too. At times I'd like to run away and take refuge in my petty ideas and then Instead, I am happy to be back to my church, to you all, and even if I will suffer and miss the heat and warmth of these three wonderful past weeks spent with my beloved ones. Yet I am sure that you are able to make me feel that warmth and love I left behind. May God help us to build His Church and not ours. Thank you for your prayers.
