God is inviting you.

The Gospel of Matthew 11:2-11 has a double focus. The first part of this Gospel concerns John the Baptist. The second part of the Gospel focuses on Jesus. John was in prison and when he heard about the works that Jesus was performing, he sent some of his disciples to go to Jesus and ask: "Are you 'He who is to come' or 'should we look for another?"

When John's disciples approached Jesus and asked him the question John had posed, Jesus replied: "Go back and report to John what you have hear and see. The blind see, the lame walk, lepers are healed., the dead are raised to life, and the poor have the good news preached to them".

John the Baptist was wondering about what Jesus was doing. He had been expecting a political Messiah and didn't understand the approach Jesus was taking. Jesus said to him, as he says to us, you have to have faith in me!

It seems that Jesus programme is not quite what John had expected.

The thing about expectations is that they pull us out of the present moment into a future we do not yet have, except as it exists in our head. Pretty soon we begin to act and speak as if our expectations, either of hope or dread, are the reality of our lives. We allowed those expectations to shape our attitudes, our beliefs, and the way we relate to others. Those expectations even shape our image of who God is, where God can show up, and how God should act. If God does not meet our expectations, we are often too guick to guestion God rather than ourselves. We trust our expectations of what God should be doing more than we trust what God is actually doing.

Now take a moment and ask yourself: Why do I turn to Jesus? Why do I seek Him out? Do I go to him because I believe in Jesus? Do I only seek Him out when I am struggling or desperate? Do I regularly spend time with Jesus? The gift is that Jesus is always there for us, waiting for us to come to Him. We often take this for granted until life gets difficult. Today make time to spend with Jesus. Jesus is always with us; However, often we are the ones do not present to him.

Matthew 11:3 "Are you the one who is to come or do we look for another"? Isaiah 50:2a "why did no one answer when I called?"






