Reflection on John 1:6-8,19-28

When we meet John in this Gospel, we immediately see it is not by happenstance that he will play out his role as the first one to identify Jesus as the Son of God: "There was a man sent from God, whose name was John" (1:6). God has chosen John and commissioned his role as a witness to Jesus.

John's witness transcends throughout all of the time as he bears witness to the light that has come into a darkened world:" John came as a witness to testify to the light, so that all might believe through him. He himself was not the light but he came to testify to the light. The true light, which enlightens everyone, was coming into the world" (1:7-9). John's role as a witness and Jesus's role as light are inseparable.

When asked about his identity. John identifies himself as the prophetic voice of one such as the figure of Isaiah whose role in the sixth century before Christ announced the return of God's people from their years of captivity in Babylon:" I am the voice of one crying out in the wilderness, make straight the way of the Lord".

John the Baptist was a man who was clear on who he was not and who he was. He is certain about who Jesus is, which enabled him to point others clearly to Jesus as the one and only saviour whom they desperately needed. We need to be clear on who we are in God's kingdom so that we can effectively point others to Jesus for salvation.

On this third Sunday of Advent, we have a unique opportunity to identify the role that all persons of faith are called to by God. Each one of us who has heard the words of this Gospel have seen the importance of John's witness to Jesus. Like John, God commissions us to bear witness to the Messiah, Jesus Christ, the one who has come in the flesh, the one who is here with us, and the one who will come again in his reign as Lord of all.

In this, there is no greater witness to the truth of God's work of salvation. Have a blessed week.


