ADVENT – A SEASON TO HOPE AGAIN

The beginning of the Christian liturgical year begins with a season of hope. Advent means "presence", "coming" and "arrival". In the first part of Advent our thoughts are drawn to his Second Coming. We are invited to top up our hearts with hope, to become a person who is always, deep down, hope-filled. How? By recalling the good things God has done for us, how he has been present in our lives, making himself known to us, resolving difficulties or calming our fears; present in the love of others, helping us to accept others and put all things in his hands. This is the work of his Spirit in our lives.

As Christmas draws near the season changes with the great Advent O antiphons (from 17th December) which are said at Evening Prayer. Our thoughts then turn to his first coming among us which we commemorate in the feast of Christmas. Filled with hope, we prepare for the Christ Mass and confess all that deprives us of hope, the sins that cling to us and the habits we need to lay aside because they prevent the Lord coming to us, to renew us in hope.

And let us not forget that every day is a day of his coming. The Lord is always with us, present to us until the end of time in the Sacrament of the Altar and in all the sacraments. He reaches out to us to forgive, to heal and to save us. Our God has not stayed hidden from our human needs but makes himself known in the human face of Jesus, Immanuel. God with us. So how do you experience God with you in your life? Can you be still in his presence and then recall his goodness to you and thank him? Then with the eyes of faith we can look on others with his eyes, eyes of hope, and set out with him to bring his mercy and peace to others.
