In preparation for the next meeting of the Synod of Bishops, the Cardinal has asked each parish to respond to four questions and the diocese will then give the feedback to the Bishops Conference:

**Question 1:** How do we witness as a Parish and proclaim our faith to those who have never heard of Christ; those who have ceased walking with Christ; those with whom we worship Christ (those who come to Church)?

**Question 2:** How should we organise ourselves as a Parish to do this more effectively?

**Question 3:** What concrete steps/formation opportunities would help us begin to witness and proclaim our faith more effectively?

**Question 4:** What structures may need to change? How might we need to develop the way we are organised currently?

Please send in your replies to the questions above by next Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> February. We would like to know your views and suggestions. You may be a long time Parishioner or new to the parish. You may have children or teenagers. You may live alone.
