### Dear Friends

So we begin another Lent, more than forty days and forty nights when we are given the invitation to consider again what it means to be a disciple of Jesus Christ. During these days we should nurture our desire to see Him more clearly, to love Him more dearly and to follow Him more nearly. Our Lenten schedule here at St Lawrence's gives us many ways to begin to do that. Don't let this Lent pass you by. Over these next four weekends Fr Fortunato, Fr Gerry and myself will be inviting you to look again at the Seven Sacraments, those outward and visible signs of inward and spiritual graces, God's ways of making us holy. St Ambrose of Milan puts it very beautifully: "You show yourself to me, O Christ, face to face: I meet you in your Sacraments." What an eye-opening way to look at it, meeting Christ Himself, every time we walk through these doors!

This weekend we are considering the Sacrament of Baptism and Confirmation, sacraments which give us a deep-down and indelible character, identity and dignity as God's own beloved sons and daughters. That divine imprint on our souls and in our lives can never be taken away from us. We are and will always be, as St Paul reminds us, a new creation. At our Baptism and again at our Confirmation we are signed on our foreheads with the Sacred Oil of Chrism, anointed to be "other Christ's" for a world that hungers for His touch, and as we are anointed these words are said, words that define the whole and rest of our lives: "God the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ has freed you from sin, given you a new birth by water, and the Holy Spirit, and welcomed you into His holy people. He now anoints you with the Chrism of salvation. As Christ was anointed Priest, Prophet and King, so may you live always as a member of His body, sharing everlasting life. Amen."

With my prayers for each and every one of you for a happy, holy and whole hearted Lent.

Mary's Meals is a charity that sets up school feeding programmes in communities where poverty and hunger prevent children from gaining an education. Mary's Meals wants your unwanted clothing and bedding (no duvets or pillows please) and will be at our church on the morning of Sunday 8th March. to collect them all. Over the next few weeks please collect your unwanted clothes and put them in tied sacks. Then on Saturday 7th or on the morning of the 8th March bring them with you when you come to Mass. Amazingly 3 full black sacks of good quality clothing will feed a child one good nutritious meal every school day for a whole year! Mary's Meals feeds children one good meal every day at school in over 12 countries. Because of their low costs they can do this for as little as £12.20 per child per year!
