Adoration means realizing that you and God belong together, to one another.

EPIPHANY means 'manifest' or 'reveal'. On the feast of Epiphany we recall three mysteries – the Magi coming bearing gifts to adore the Christ child, Our Lord's Baptism in the Jordan (this year not on a Sunday but on Monday 8th January) and the manifestation of his glory as the heavenly bridegroom at the Wedding in Cana. God is always manifesting, unveiling, revealing himself to those who have faith and are open to him. The Sacred Scriptures are a record of the manifestation of God, first to his Chosen People then to the Gentiles the whole world. God is available to all. This unveiling or revelation is of a new dispensation in this world which runs counter to the culture humans have set up for themselves. God reveals himself to be unlike any of our gods. He is not in competition with anyone. He is God.

The only way to freedom of heart, freedom from sinful human dynamics, is to orientate our lives towards God. This is God's project in our lives.

In his Epiphany homily in 2020 Pope Francis said:

"Faith demands adoration. If we can fall on our knees before Jesus, we will overcome the temptation to set off on our own path. For adoration involves making an exodus from the greatest form of bondage: slavery to oneself. Adoration means putting the Lord at the centre, not ourselves. It means giving things their rightful place, and giving the first place to God. Adoration means making God's plan more important than our personal time, our entitlements and our spaces. It is to accept the teaching of Scripture: "You shall worship the Lord your God" (Mt 4:10). Your God: adoration means realizing that you and God belong together, to one another. It means being able to speak to him freely and intimately. It means bringing our lives to him and letting him enter into them. It means letting his consolation come down to earth. Adoration means discovering that, in order to pray, it is enough to say: "My Lord and my God!", and to let ourselves be pervaded by his tender love."

Thank you for revealing to me more of God's love and goodness. Thank you to you all and to Fr John for these past 16 months with you at St Lawrence. I count myself the most blessed of Westminster priests! What a remarkable and vibrant parish. A previous much-loved former parish priest of yours told me the day I started – 1 September 2022: "They are a difficult parish to leave". I think you know who that was. He is right. But I go with deep gratitude and joy in my heart. Thank you. Thank you. Thank you.

> O worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness; bow down before him, his glory proclaim; with gold of obedience, and incense of lowliness, kneel and adore him: the Lord is his name.
