# Dear Friends,

Last Thursday we witnessed the funeral of Pope Benedict XVI. I suspect that theologians and commentators will argue for many years to come about Benedict's legacy. Some will talk of his teachings, others about his successful visit to the UK in 2010, and who could forget the "Gods Rottweiler" description, but for me the relationship he had with Pope Francis would be amongst his greatest achievements. There are certainly some who would seek to exploit the relationship between the "two men in white" but I believe that Benedict was loyal to Francis and that Francis valued Benedict's succinct wisdom. Indeed, I understand Francis once said that having Benedict around was like having a grandfather living with you.

Today is the feast of The Baptism of the Lord. I'm sure that most of you who are reading this won't remember your own baptisms because, of course, you were baptised as infants. But in His baptism, Jesus revealed to us His divinity, and in a similar way our divine lives began with our baptisms, the day when we were born as sons and daughters of God.

Our baptisms brought us many gifts. God marked our souls as belonging to him as his beloved son or daughter, He cleansed our souls of sin, original sin if we were baptised as infants and personal sin if we were baptised after reaching the age of reason.

At our baptisms God placed divine life in our souls, and everything that is required for that divine life - virtue, faith, hope and charity, prudence, justice and fortitude. Additionally, God gave us the gifts of the Holy Spirit wisdom, knowledge, counsel, piety and fear of the Lord, in fact everything we need for our divine lives has been given to us in "seed form" to be nourished and protected so we can all come to the fullness of life in Christ. Having divine life in our souls we become living members of the Body of Christ, so baptism is so much more than joining a club or a group. The group that we have joined is our Church, with Christ as its head and with us as the living members.


