I know I have said a few times now that we live in troubled times. The wars in the Middle East and Ukraine together with an increasingly number of difficult domestic issues closer to home certainly has the possibility to bring about some kind of toxic mixture from which it is going to be difficult to recover. It is indeed fortunate for us that we have our faith, which is as important to us now as it was at any previous time to our ancestors.

In today's Gospel, Jesus tells us all to "repent, and believe." I know that many of you pray Compline every evening. Personally, I find Compline very powerful as it gives me an opportunity to examine my conscience. It is important that we examine our conscience daily, reflecting upon what thoughts, beliefs and goals are driving us in our daily life. This self-reflection should raise the question of what is it that would make life worthwhile?

...Our Lord Jesus Christ presents to us in simple terms with the most important thing of all. He says "the time has come and the Kingdom of God is close at hand." "Repent, and believe the Good News." To me that sums up the Gospel in just a few words. The Gospel in its totality should have our full approval. The Good News is Jesus, His teaching and His grace. God is with us, addressing us as friends and inviting us to live in His friendship. Our response should be that of faith in His person and in His teaching. It is when we accept this then we can travel through these troubled times.
