Dear Friends,

Yesterday, we celebrated a Mass of thanksgiving for the many volunteers who give freely of their time to make our parish the vibrant, prayerful community that it is. It would certainly be fair to say that our parish would not be able to function in the way that it does without their contribution, and so I thank all our volunteers for their help and their hard work.

Recently, I heard an astronomer on TV state that were it not for rain then our planet would be nothing more than an inert lump of rock in space exactly like all the others. I don't know if this individual is a believer or not but unwittingly he illustrated to us the meaning of today's reading from Isaiah and today's Gospel from Matthew.

We live in a time when there are words and advice coming from all angles of the media. Some of it is misguided but well intentioned and some of it is accurate but badly received. Some is malicious and even spiteful.

In today's Gospel Jesus compares "words" to a seed. Isn't that a wonderful image? I don't think we have any parishioners who work in agriculture but I know many of you are keen gardeners, (sadly I am not) but I do understand enough that a seed has to grow in fertile ground to bear fruit. That of course is great, but what of the seeds that aren't grown in fertile soil? Those that fall on the edge of the path represent those who are closed to God's call. Those that fall on the rock represent those who resist God's call. Sadly, I feel that those who fall in the thorns represent many of us who live in The West, as they are so full of worldly issues that God's word is somehow drowned out by all the noise from the media and twenty first century living. I don't think this group set out to deliberately exclude God it's just that somehow there is no room for God.

God has clearly spoken to our volunteers because when they listened they were motivated by his love. But we should also remember that all of us (and not just our volunteers) are sowers of his word. So exactly like the rain that sustains our planet, it is incumbent upon us to sustain each other, and we shouldn't be discouraged if no harvest is immediately apparent. As Christians, and particularly as Catholic Christians our task is to continue sowing and leave the harvest to God.
