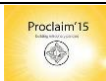

Dear Friends,

This summer, twelve of us from St Lawrence's have answered the invitation from Pope Francis to join him in Poland for World Youth Day. On Monday we will be leaving London by coach, together with two hundred others from around the Diocese, and making our way to join the million or more other young Catholics from across the world for this grand festival of faith. I have taken groups to a number of World Youth Days over the years – Rome in 2000, Toronto in 2002, Cologne in 2005, Sydney in 2008, Madrid in 2010 – and I'm more and more convinced of the power and potential of these moments to inspire our young people, to call them to greatness, to confirm them in their faith and to give them an experience of this great and universal Church we belong to, gathered around our Pope, and then sent back home to be missionaries of the love and mercy and majesty of our God.

The theme that Pope Francis has given us this year is straight from the Gospel of St Matthew, Chapter 5 verse 7: "*Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy*". This is a challenging theme but a beautiful and transforming invitation to reflect on how we both give and receive mercy in our lives. Our pilgrimage will include a visit to the Shrine of the Divine Mercy just outside Krakow, and I'll be praying for you all there, that Divine Mercy will touch you.

In the meantime, pray for all our young pilgrims – Rebecca, Tanya, Josh, Dominic, Reeve, Clayton, Darren, David, Thang, Lloyd, and Tanya and myself as group leaders – and ask that this World Youth Day will be a time of real blessing and the start of something beautiful in our lives.

### MEDAILLE TRUST

We welcome a representative from the Medaille Trust who will be appealing at all Masses this weekend. The Medaille Trust is a charity founded by groups of Religious congregations in 2006 to work against the evils of human trafficking in response to the plight of thousands of people who are being trafficked into the UK each year. The Trust has been a significant provider of support and safe house provision for the victims of human trafficking since then and continues to deliver outstanding care ten years on. The primary mission of The Medaille Trust is the empowerment of women, men and children, who have been freed from the human-trafficking and the modern day slavery industry in the UK, enabling them to regain their dignity and self-worth. We do this by providing safe housing and offering opportunities for physical and psychological healing, rehabilitation and protection to the victims in our care.
