Applying the Parable of the Sower.

The parable of the Sower is one of Jesus' most well-known parables. And for good reason. This story has implications that are just as powerful today, as they were the first time Jesus told it.

We can learn much about our circumstances of life from the parable of the Sower. We can learn that as we go through life there is always a real possibility of falling away from God. Jesus said there are those who have heard the word of God and as they go their way, they are choked with worries, riches, and pleasures of this life (Luke 8:14)

In the Gospel according to Mark 4:18,19 records that because of the worries of the world, the deceitfulness of riches, and the desires for other things, will choke the word and it will become unfruitful. This process of having the word of God choked out of us is usually a gradual occurrence from which we must be constantly on guard. When we consider that our eternal salvation is only through Jesus Christ, to let that slip away because we are more concerned with worry and other things is a tragic loss.

Instead of being choked by things, we ought to be like the seed sown in good soil which yields a crop, some one hundred-fold, some -sixty, some - thirty. A crop produced in our lives by living as the word of God teaches is what Jesus expects of us. Because we all surely have different abilities and talents, Jesus only expects us to use what we've been given. Just as it takes time for a crop to grow from a seed, it likely will take time for us to develop our crop of life. It will likely take time for us, just like it would a crop, but we are consistently growing.

Just like the mustard seed, our faith is not something big that crashes on us. It always starts small, but we must take care of it to make it grow. It has to be planted. It has to form its roots for it to fully grow, live and bear its fruits.

Have you ever considered whether the word of God is producing greater results today in your life as compared to last year? I believe a periodic evaluation is most useful.

If you're not where you want to be spiritually, today is a fresh start to plant your seeds in good soil so you can strengthen your relationship with Jesus as God wants you to do. This is otherwise known as God's Will.
