Dear Friends

I am delighted to be able to announce that the Archbishop is sending us an Assistant Priest to take up residence here and start his ministry with us in September. He is *Fortunato Pantisano*, at present a Deacon in Chiswick parish and preparing for his Ordination to the Sacred Priesthood in Westminster Cathedral on Saturday 29th June at 10.30am to which we are all warmly invited. If you want another sneak preview of our new priest his First Mass will be the following day, Sunday 30th June at 12.30pm in Our Lady of Grace & St Edward, Chiswick High Road.

There will be ample opportunity for "Fr Fortunato" to introduce himself but, for now, he is 33 years old, comes originally from Calabria in southern Italy and is a member of the Neo-Catechumenal Way. I know him well from my days as Vocations Director – and I know how blest we will be to have him. Please pray for him as he prepares for Priesthood and for making his new home with us. I am delighted too that Daniel Humphreys will be keeping his home-base here when he goes to Allen Hall seminary in September. We won't be seeing quite so much of him then but it will make his home-coming all the more joyful.
