Tenth Sunday of the Year

Dear Friends.

A permanent deacon is a man called by God to serve his community in the threefold ministries of the word, the altar and charity. He is allowed to proclaim the Gospel and is authorised to preside at baptisms, weddings and funerals. He can preside over prayer and scripture services. He cannot say Mass or hear confessions.

It was over five years ago that I was first asked to consider putting myself forward for formation to the Permanent Diaconate. It has been three years since I began formal formation. During this time, I have often found my formation challenging, but also inspiring, enlightening and of course truly rewarding. As my period of pre-ordination formation draws to a close I would like to thank you all for your prayers, love and support that you have all given to me during this time.

I haven't yet had formal confirmation of ordination but I will almost certainly be ordained a Permanent Deacon at 12:30pm on June 23rd at Westminster Cathedral and I look forward with humility to serving our parish for many years to come.

St Lawrence (Martyr of Rome) and patron saint of our parish was a deacon, as was St Francis of Assisi, whom I know many of you have a particular devotion to. So with this in mind, could I ask that you continue to remember me in your prayers, as I will remember you in mine, and perhaps reflect on this piece of scripture as I begin my ministry at St Lawrence's.

Acts of the Apostles 6:1-7

About this time, when the number of disciples was increasing, the Hellenists made a complaint against the Hebrews: in the daily distribution their own widows were being overlooked.

So the Twelve called a full meeting of the disciples and addressed them, "It would not be right for us to neglect the word of God so as to give out food;

Brothers, you must select from among yourselves seven men of good reputation, filled with the Spirit and with wisdom, to whom we can hand over this duty.

We ourselves will continue to devote ourselves to prayer and to the service of the word."

The whole assembly approved of this proposal and elected Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit, together with Philip, Prochorus, Nicanor, Timon, Parmenas, and Nicolaus of Antioch, a convert to Judaism.

They presented these to the apostles, and after prayer they laid their hands on them.

The word of the Lord continued to spread: the number of disciples in Jerusalem was greatly increased, and a large group of priests made their submission to the faith.
