What God asks

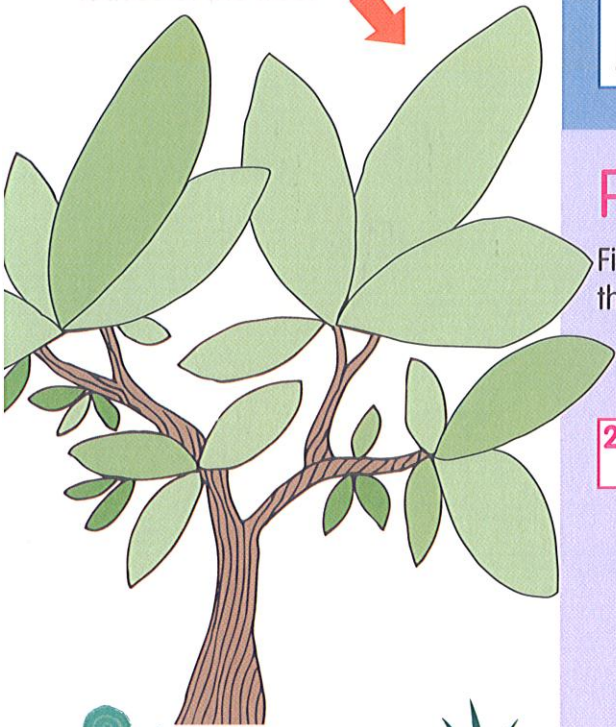

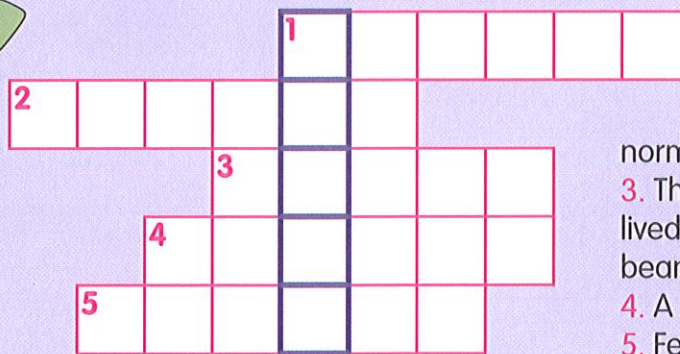
Spot the difference
