BLESSED CARLO ACUTIS

Born in London 3 May 1991; Died in Monza, Italy, 12 October 2006

After the Homily at the 11am Mass today the Icon of Blessed Carlo will be blessed and we will say the prayer below together.

Born in 1991, in London, Blessed Carlo Acutis grew up in Italy. He died at the age of 15, full of faith, in 2006. It is in his remarkable holiness that we can trace the signs of Christ's transformative love. From an early age he was drawn to the Lord in the Eucharist and to his Blessed Mother. Here are some of his sayings to meditate on:

- 1. To be always united with Jesus, this is my plan of life.
- 2. Our aim has to be the infinite and not the finite.

The infinite is our homeland. We have always been expected in heaven.

- 3. All people are born as originals but many die as photocopies.
- 4. Sadness is looking at ourselves, happiness is looking towards God.

5. When we face the sun we get a tan... but when we stand before Jesus in the Eucharist we become saints.

6. What does it matter if you can win a thousand battles if you cannot win against your own corrupt passions? It doesn't matter. The real battle is with ourselves.

7. I offer all the suffering I will have to suffer for the Lord, for the Pope, and the Church.

8. The Eucharist, my highway to heaven.

9. The only thing we have to ask God for, in prayer, is the desire to be holy.

10. "Mama, I would like to leave this hospital, but I know I will not do so alive. I will give you signs though, that I'm with God. I die happy because I did not spend my life wasting my time on things not pleasing to God."

O God, our Father we thank you for giving us Carlo, a model of life for young people, and a message of love for all. You made him fall in love with you Son, Jesus, making the Eucharist his "highway to heaven". You gave him Mary, as a beloved Mother and you made him. through the Rosary. a cantor of her tenderness. Receive his prayer for us. Look above all upon the poor, whom he loved and assisted. Grant me too, through his intercession, the grace that I need (mention your intention); And make our joy full, by raising Carlo among the saints of your Church, so that his smile shines again for us to the glory of your name. Amen
