Dear Friends,

November is the month of the dead when we remember and pray for all those who have gone to God before us. Today is of course Remembrance Sunday and could I ask that we pray for all our War Dead especially:

Brian Patrick Brownlie Geoffrey Gerrard Chilton Lucien Angelo Colarossi William Edward Cummins William Prince Edwards Richard John Humphries Peter Joseph McKeown Brendan John Scanlon William Curran

These men were all parishioners at St Lawrence's. They would have sat on the same benches that we still sit on today. Some would have been altar boys serving on the same sanctuary that we still celebrate Mass at today. I suspect that some of them would have known Fr Bridgeman who was our parish priest between 1936 and 1967. I know we still have a few parishioners who remember Fr Bridgeman so that connection with our past is the same connection that ultimately connects us to leave

We can and we should remember those who gave their lives in both World Wars and other conflicts to bring us peace. Although, that said, with the current conflicts in Ukraine and Gaza it seems to me that there is no peace at the moment. So could I also ask that we remember those innocent civilians, many of whom are children and vulnerable adults in our prayers today.

Fortunately, for us, when we are in right relationship with God and those around us, it is possible to find an interior peace and serenity that material satisfaction doesn't give us. Ironically, it is something that is often visible to others before we realise it in ourselves.

In today's Gospel we are reminded we should be like the wise virgins, we should have our lamps ready for the coming of Christ. I often think our lifetimes work to be some kind of a pilgrimage or a journey, but particularly so at this time of the year as we are preparing for Advent. So now is the time to ask ourselves, are we ready for the coming of Christ? Are our lamps burning brightly or have we let our lamps go out? And perhaps most importantly of all do we sometimes fall asleep?

So, as we prepare for Advent I ask you all to keep your lamps bright, to keep praying, to keep that relationship with Jesus alive. Now would be a great time to experience the sacraments, (particularly, if you haven't been for a while, the sacrament of reconciliation). Try and find a moment to sit in silence every day and listen to what God is asking of you, and please be loving with your neighbour, even if your neighbour is on the other side of a political division.
