St Lawrence Catholic Primary School, our Parish School, is in urgent need of new Foundation Governors. Fund Raising is extremely important to us as we need to raise our contribution of £140,000 towards the new 'El-Camino' teaching block. As we are a voluntary aided school, The Parish Community and Governors are required to pay 10% of all costs towards any Capital Project in the School. A Foundation Governor is appointed in the name of the Archbishop of Westminster at the recommendation of either the Headteacher or the Chair of Governors, and their responsibility is to preserve the Catholic character of the school. Governors will need to be able to attend a meeting of the Governing Board every Half-Term and serve on either the Resources Committee or Curriculum Committee once every Term.
