I wonder how many of us are guilty of procrastination. I know I certainly am. Never do today what you can put off until tomorrow seems to be the cultural norm of the modern era. Or is it? It seems to me much more likely that this a characteristic that is something that has haunted humanity since time began. Quite frankly, there is always some reason that prevents us from doing what we know we should be doing.

In today's Gospel a great king arranges a banquet for his son's wedding. But for some reason no one wanted to come. What Jesus is really saying when he says "come to the wedding feast" is "come into the kingdom" but for whatever reason we all have excuses. Then Jesus challenges us to go out onto the streets and the crossroads and invite everyone to come in. If that wasn't enough he then says that some who are not properly dressed should be thrown out.

The parable of the Wedding Banquet is good news to the unworthy, the people who are on the streets and at the crossroads, those who were invited when the original guests of honour had responded so ungratefully. It is bad news for those original guests as well as for the man without the wedding garment.

The Eucharist foreshadows the heavenly banquet at which the Father celebrates the wedding of his Son. Unlike the ungrateful guests, we should gratefully accept his generous invitation. Like the unworthy guests, we do not deserve our invitation and we should resolve to live lives that make us worthy guests at such a feast.

So don't put off until tomorrow what you know you should be doing today. When Jesus says leave everything he means your bad habits (in my case procrastination) and follow Him, and when you do follow Him, then be properly dressed because you are coming to serve God, and that requires the suitable attire of love and humility.
