This Parish is part of Westminster Roman Catholic Diocesan Trust (WRCDT) Registered Charity No: 233699 Today's gospel presents us with a summation of all parables – the parable of parables - because it concerns the Lord Jesus who comes to his Father's vineyard, which has been cultivated and cared for with love and tenderness, only to be rejected and killed. This is the story of Jesus and the story of humanity.

God cultivates his people, as the prophet tells us, in love so that we can bear fruit – the fruit of charity. But because of pride, competition for power and wealth humanity has gone blind to the word of God and followed its own way.

Yet Jesus is the stone rejected by humanity. He is the keystone of a new society, a new civilisation built on forgiving love among those who are willing to accept him.

On a global scale we pray that as COP28 draws near (Dubai, 30 Nov – 12 Dec) the leaders of the nations will not be deaf to the prophetic words offered by Pope Francis in his Apostolic Exhortation, Laudate Deum (Praise God).

Pope Francis pleads that power be used to protect life. "Not every increase in power represents progress for humanity." (#24). He tells us that "when human beings claim to take God's place, they become their own worst enemies." (#73). Instead "Let us stop thinking, then, of human beings as autonomous, omnipotent and limitless, and begin to think of ourselves differently, in a humbler but more fruitful way."

Today we pray for the work of CAFOD in its many projects in the vineyard of God's earth so that it may be home for all his children. Let us also give thanks for the fruit that our Catholic Agency of Overseas Development bears in the lives of so many others. Thank you for your generous donations and support.

God of love, show us our place in this world as the channels of your love for all creatures of this earth, for not one of them is forgotten in your sight. Enlighten those who possess power and money that they may avoid the sin of indifference, that they may love the common good, advance the weak, and care for this world in which we live. The poor and the earth are crying out. O Lord, seize us with your power and light, help us to protect all life, to prepare for a better future, for the coming of your Kingdom Of justice, peace, love and beauty. Praise be to you! Amen. (prayer from Encyclical Letter Laudato Si, 2015)
