PARKING POLICY

For the health and safety of everyone at St Lawrence's, bearing in mind our duty of care for one another, and to ensure access for emergency vehicles to the Church, School, Presbytery and Parish Centre at all times, the following policy comes into force with immediate effect:

Parking around the Church, Presbytery and Parish Centre

Parking around the Church, Presbytery and Parish Centre on weekdays and at weekends is very limited. Parking is not permitted on the yellow grid boxes at any time. It is only allowed in the designated parking spaces marked in yellow and in the few available spaces around the Parish Centre.

Priority parking should always be given to our elderly and less able parishioners, particularly at weekday and weekend Masses.

Parking at the School

At the weekends we are fortunate to have the use of the school car park on almost every Sunday of the year. There are 16 spaces with room for 4 cars along the fence at the edge of the car park. Once these spaces are filled the car park is full and no more cars are permitted to park. There is to be no double parking or parking down the centre of the car park.

Again, this is to ensure access for emergency vehicles and safe pedestrian access from Victoria Road.

Given the limited availability of parking spaces at St Lawrence's, parishioners are encouraged to use alternative local parking facilities.

If necessary and if parking continues to be an issue, the parish will need to recruit volunteers as parking attendants. The attendants will lower the barrier for the school car park once it is full.
